BC Minor Update

BC Minor/BC Baseball has agreed to allow tiering in WRSSBA in the Mosquito division for a one year trial period (for in-house play); trial program to be will be evaluated at end of season. No releases accepted from other associations. We will provide a report on the implementation and execution of this pilot project at the end of the season. House rules will apply to the different tiers. Consideration of fairness to be given to the level of skill/play of our teams entering 11U tournaments this season.

LL 11/12 exception can continue for the 2017 season as per original letter of agreement with BC Minor

WRSSBA has negotiated with BC Minor the ability for us to offer a LL 13yr old Intermediate team for the 2017.

WRSSBA will not offer Bantam AAA in 2017 as top-tier players will be playing on the Tritons prep team.

<u>Motion</u>: To readjust coordinators roles to reflect new divisions; Randy McKinnon to act as 11U (Mosquito) Division Coordinator, Todd Nadon to act as LL 11/12 Division Coordinator and Dana Davis to act as13U (Peewee) Division Coordinator.
