## WRSSBA Scholarship Requirements

---

The White Rock South Surrey Baseball Association wishes to support young athletes in their post-secondary endeavours. Two \$250 scholarships will be awarded each year.

### Eligibility Requirements:

To qualify for this Scholarship, the applicant must:

1. Have been a member in good standing a minimum of five consecutive years of spring season baseball with WRSSBA, with the last year being U18. The applicant must be enrolled with the WRSSBA in the grade 12 year (graduating year 18U).

Note: Exceptions will be made on a case by case basis by the Association's executive for special circumstances, for example: where the Association did not field a team at the U18 level of play appropriate to the applicant.

2. The applicant (not the parent) must submit a brief letter outlining what playing White Rock South Surrey baseball meant to him/her. The applicant will describe any volunteer work they have done for the WRSSBA and/or other community involvement (with preference to WRSSBA volunteerism). They must confirm their eligibility for this scholarship.

3. The applicant must attend a post-secondary academic institution within 6 months of the application deadline of July 31st. Proof of enrollment at the academic institution must be submitted and once verified the association will write the applicant a cheque for \$250 from the WRSSBA.
