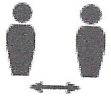
**Conditions of Use**

Do not use metal pegs to anchor nets as they can cause serious injury to parks maintenance crews mowing the grass. Use velcro straps, or plastic pegs only-no tape. Please clean up litter/debris from field and bleachers at completion of play each day. Licensee must not block or consume the common areas. Licensee must be respectful to the neighborhood with noise never exceeding the local government Noise Bylaw. Inflatable structures are not permitted on City of White Rock property without prior permission. The City of White Rock's "Public Health Smoking Protection Bylaw" prohibits smoking in any outdoor gathering place under the jurisdiction of the City of White Rock including parks, sports fields, playgrounds, the promenade, the pier and the beach. Proof of third-party liability insurance in the amount of at least \$5 million per occurrence must be submitted a minimum of 5 business days in advance of rental. "The Corporation Of The City Of White Rock" must be listed as an additional insured.

**Covid-19 Public Health Requirements - Applicable to all Rental Agreements**

It is the renter's responsibility to comply with all rules and regulations from the Provincial Health Officer, Fraser Health Authority, Provincial/ National Sport Organizations, WorkSafeBC and any other applicable authority or law designed to reduce the potential of contracting or transmitting COVID-19. Further, it is the renters responsibility to meet changing or new COVID-19 regulations as the regulations are subject to change from the date of the rental booking and the date of the rental occurring.
