This is a baseball Canada rule that you will encounter in older divisions and in national competition. WRSSBA will start to implement a rule that once you assume pitching you cannot catch for the remainder of the day. This will be a house rule and anytime you play outside teams you can ask them to follow it but it isn't a BC Minor rule. Randy will go to the drafts to discuss this with the coaches as well.
