2.0 New Business	New Indoor Facility – Update, budget and schedule Foundation & hydro passed inspection, and the new building structure frame has been put up now and the project is progressing as planned and on schedule for Feb 1 completion date. 	Registration Update	

	<p>Registration is open and has had a strong response. Once divisions reach their max they will be auto waitlisted with the new TeamSnap version we are using.</p> <p>Registration Limits have been set as follows due to structural capacity imitations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 18U is capped at 28 • 15U is capped at 72 - 10 spots are being held back at 15U to account for the player releases from the Tritons program. 15U program is capped due to field limitations. • 13U is capped at 149 • 11U is capped at 144 • 9U & 8U are capped at 96 • 7U & 8U are capped at 112 • 5U is capped at 80 <p>To reduce emails required form the registrar there was a detailed FAQ created as well as an auto reply from the registrar email to indicate that if the question has been answered in the FAQ they will not be getting a reply.</p>	
	<p>13U AAA/15U AA Team Selection Process</p> <p>For the month of January both divisions will have 7 sessions each with gradual cuts through the month. Once the cuts are down to 16 the coaches will be selected, and the final cuts will be made from there. A player must attend a minimum of 4 sessions to be evaluated.</p>	
	<p>Volunteer Fee Transition</p> <p>There have been several questions coming up around this fee transition. Main questions have been around those who volunteered last year and had paid last year as well.</p>	
	<p>Umpires for 2026</p> <p>Our number of umpires have increased year over year, and we only have a 17% turnover rate. We have 78/94 umpires from last year intending to return so we will only be onboarding 15 new umpires for the 2026 season. There will be a selection process for the candidates and an email has been sent out to the association to explain this.</p>	
	<p>Open Discussion:</p> <p>Provincials</p> <p>It would be very interesting to look into hosting provincials at either the 11U or 15U level in the future.</p> <p>Field Maintenance</p> <p>SSAP Bantam Field – There will be work done to fix the large lips on the infield as it can be quite dangerous. This item has been taken to Brad from the city, and it will be addressed.</p> <p>Laronde – There are bathrooms being installed at Laronde.</p> <p>Crescent Park – This field will get some good care and attention prior to the 2026 season starting.</p>	

	Bakerview – Still have a need for fencing/netting to prevent foul ball loss, this was promised last year from the city but not delivered upon.
